1. Who are eligible to apply for MAHATET exam? Application Criteria? Different criteria are applicable for Paper I & II

3. How to apply for MAHATET examination? What is the process/procedure to apply for the MAHATET exam?

Visit the MAHATET exam official website https://mahatet.in

- a. Register yourself on MAHATET (https://mahatet.in) under the new registration link.
- b. Login Login to MAHATET portal using created MAHATET Username & Password
- c. Fill / Submit the Application form with proper details
- d. Make Payment Make exam fees Payment online
- e. Transaction History If payment is successfully done then get the Transaction receipt & now you are registered for the MAHATET Exam
- f. Application Print Take the Print out of completed MAHATET application form

4. How payments will be accepted?

All payments will be accepted Online (Through Debit card / Credit Card / Net Banking / UPI / QR)

5. How to get the Username & Password?

Candidate have to create Username and Password by himself / herself while creating the registration.

6. I didn't get the OTP on email/mobile after clicking on the Send OTP Button?

You might have entered the WRONG mobile number so please check your registered email Inbox / Spam box to get the MAHATET Username /Password (Vice-a-versa). If provided Mobile number & mail ID both are Wrong then kindly Re-register yourself with new/valid Email Id & Mobile No also the OTP on Email id and Mobile No are same.

7. What are the documents required to be uploaded on Registration/Application form?

No documents should be uploaded at the time of filling Candidate registration form. On Application form user will have to upload his latest Photograph, Signature, Identity Proof and Self Declaration separately.

8. How to edit the Candidate photo on Application form?

Candidate can edit photograph before making payment. Once the payment is done successfully, candidate won't be able to edit photo or other information in application form. For changing photo (before making payment) click on "Re-Upload" button, a form will open where user should click on "Choose File "option on Candidate Application form & upload new photo.

9. How to edit the Candidate information?

** If you have successfully paid the MAHATET application fees then you CAN NOT edit the Candidate details on Application form. For changing candidate information (before making payment) please click on Application Link and the whole form will be open in edit mode and candidate then able to edit his mentioned information.

10. I have submitted the Candidate registration form? Are we done with MAHATET Application?

Only after the successful payment of the exam fees Candidate will be Successfully registered on the system. Please take the printout of MAHATET application form post successful payment.

11. How to pay the Candidate fees online?

Once Candidate preview /Confirm & submits Application form he / she gets Re-directed

to Payment page where user should click on "Payment" Button, on click one final popup should be displayed for confirmation and If you click on "Yes" button then it diverts candidate to Payment Gateway (Billdesk) page where user can perform the payment using (Debit card / Credit cards / Net banking / UPI / QR).

12. From where I can check the Payment status & download transaction receipt?

Click on "Fill Exam Fee" link on Candidate dashboard to check the Payment status.

13. After performing the transaction getting status as "Transaction failed" what to do?

If payment transaction is failed, then in 72 hours the amount will either deposited to Maharashtra State council of examination's account or it will refund to the candidate's account.

14. After performing the transaction getting status as "Pending" what to do?

If the candidate's payment transaction is successful but somehow the payment information is not updated in the system, Then the payment information will be updated within 72 hours in the system and then candidate can able to take a print out of his/her application form.

15. Unable to fill information in the fields on Candidate Registration / Application form?

You are missing fields at the time of filling registration form. Kindly fill the form fields SEQUENTIALLY (One by One) without missing any field to overcome this issue.

16. I forgot the MAHATET Password, what to do?

The "Forgot Password" link is provided on the https://mahatet.in portal by entering your Email Id and Mobile No. candidate can get his/her password.
