

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions) - MAHATET – JUNE-2026

Q No 1. Who are eligible to apply for MAHATET exam? Application Criteria? Different criteria are applicable for Paper I & II.

Q. No. 3. How to apply for MAHATET examination? What is the process/procedure to apply for? the MAHATET exam?

Step 1: - Register yourself on MAHATET portal and note down your Username and Password.

Step 2: - Login - Login to MAHATET portal using created Username & Password

Step 3: - Fill / Submit the Application form with proper details

Step 4: - Make Payment - Make exam fees Payment online

Step 5: - Transaction History - If payment is successfully done then get the Transaction receipt &

now you are registered for the MAHATET Exam

Step 6: - Application Print - Take the Print out of completed MAHATET application form

Q. No 4. How payments will be accepted?

All payments will be accepted Online Through Debit card / Credit Card / Internet Banking /UPI/QR Etc.

Q. No 5. How to get the Username & Password?

The candidate must fill out the registration form available on the MAHATET website. Upon successful submission of the OTP received on the registered mobile number, a popup screen will display the candidate's login credentials. Candidates should carefully note these details. In case the login credentials are forgotten, they can be retrieved using the 'Forgot Username and Password' link.

Q. No 6. I didn't get the TET Registration OTP over mobile?

In this situation, the candidate should check whether DND (Do Not Disturb) is activated on the registered mobile number and ensure that the mobile number has active incoming services

Q No 7. What are the documents required to be uploaded on Registration/Application form?

No documents are required at the time of new registration. However, while completing the Application Form, the candidate must upload the latest photograph, signature, a valid government ID proof (as specified in the form), and a handwritten self-declaration with the left-hand thumb impression. In case of a name change or being an ex-serviceman or a differently-abled person or the wife/family member of a martyred soldier, the candidate must upload the relevant supporting certificates

Q. No 8. How to edit the Candidate photo on Application form?

The candidate can edit the photograph before making the payment. Once the payment is successfully completed, no changes to the photograph or any other information in the application form will be allowed. To change the photograph (before payment), click on the 'Edit Application' button. The application form will open, where the candidate should select the 'Choose File' option to upload a new photograph. After uploading, click on the 'Save & Preview' button to save the changes.

Q. No 9. How to edit the Candidate information?

Once the MAHATET application fee has been successfully paid, candidates will NOT be able to edit their details in the Application Form. To make changes before payment, log in to the Candidate Portal and select the 'Edit Application' button. This option is available at the bottom of the 'Preview' screen. Click on the 'Edit Application' button to update the candidate details in the form

Q. No 10. I have submitted the Candidate registration form? Are we done with MAHATET Application?

A candidate will be successfully registered in the system only after the exam fee has been paid. After successful registration, candidates must take a printout of the MAHATET application form for their

records.

Q. No 11. How to pay the Candidate fees online?

Once Candidate preview /Confirm & submits Application form he / she gets Re-directed to Payment page where user should click on “Payment” Button, on click it diverts user to Payment Gateway (Bill desk) page where user can perform the payment using (Debit card / Credit cards / Net banking/QR Code etc.)

Q No 12. From where I can check the Payment status & download transaction receipt?

Candidate can check his/her payment status by clicking on “परीक्षा शुल्क” link. If payment is successful then candidate can see the download button to download payment receipt.

Q No 13. After performing the transaction getting status as “Transaction failed “What to do?

If the transaction is failed then in this case user have to login again and perform the transaction.

Q No 14. After performing the transaction getting status as “Pending” what to do?

In this situation, the payment will either be refunded to the candidate’s transaction bank account or to the Maharashtra State Council of Examination, Pune’s bank account. This process may take at least 72 hours (3 working days), and the candidate is requested to wait until the transaction is settled

Q No 15. I forgot the MAHATET Username or Password, what to do?

If you forgot the MAHATET Username then use “Forgot Username and Password” option to get the Login details.

Q No 16. Unable to change the Email ID/ Mobile on Application form?

You cannot change the Email ID/Mobile number on Application form as you have already confirmed it at the time of registration

Q. No 17. What are the applicable fees for the exam?

Q. No 18. Unable to print MAHATET application form.

You can ONLY print the application form after successful Payment.

No, you cannot make any changes after successful Payment, so kindly Preview the form before proceeding with Payment.
